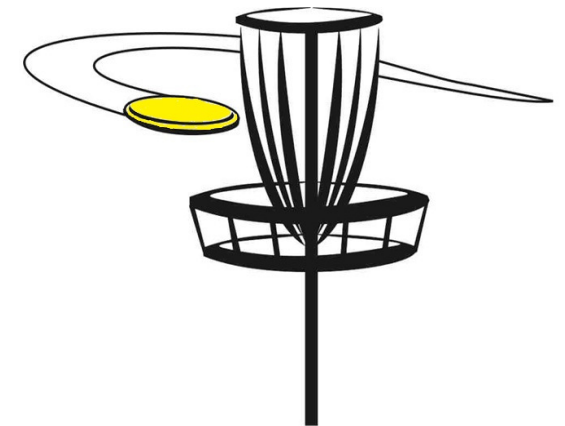

# New course open in Merrill Park in Parish

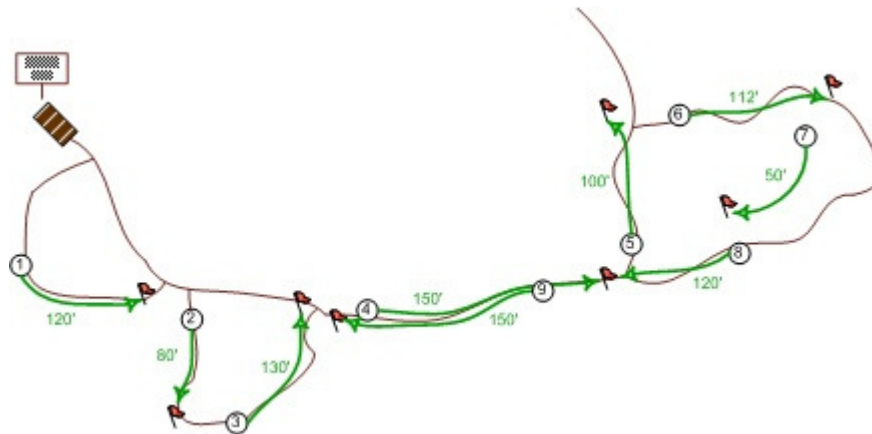
